SAIChE is recognised by the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) as a Voluntary Association, category A.

To this end it:

- Provides opportunities for professional development of its members.
- Monitors chemical engineering education in South Africa.
- Provides Continuing Professional Development (CPD) accreditation (SAIChE is recognised by ECSA as a CPD Licensed Body).

Services Offered

- Regular conferences, courses, seminars, workshops and meetings through its branches in: Gauteng, KwaZulu-Natal, and Western Cape, as well as international.
- Course accreditation at tertiary education institutions.
- Career guidance to schools, pupils and their parents.
- Liaison with engineering and scientific associations on subjects of interest to wider audiences.
